

### Software Rules

#### **Combat' 09**

2<sup>nd</sup> All Pakistan Programming, Software and Hardware competition.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

In order for a person to participate in this software competition, all team members must be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program. Every member of each team must bring the ID card or student certificate with them. A team may consist of maximum 5 members.

#### **REGISTRATION:**

The complete registration requires the following documents to be submitted before the deadline.

- Online registration form
- Student certification form
- Registration fee

The registration form is available on the **COMBAT** website(<http://www.combat.org.pk>), at the registration link of the Software Competition.

The form must be filled and submitted online.

All participants must submit the "Student Certification Form" signed by the academic officer of their institute to identify them as currently enrolled undergraduate student of the institute.

#### **RULES And GUIDENCE:**

1. Participants are needed to provide a report on their project containing project title detail description of project and member information with the entry form.
2. Teams must bring their own CPUs to avoid any software or hardware related problems. All participants should bring all CDs of software required to run the project perfectly. Monitors will be provided to participants.
3. Accessories requirements must be mentioned on the registration form, which they need; otherwise the organizers will not be responsible to provide any further requirements.

4. All teammates must be the student of same institute
5. The registered participants of each team need to report at 08:30 am sharp on the days of competition.

**JUDGMENT:**

- The Jury is responsible for the final judgment.
- In exceptional cases, the Jury reserves the right to make amendments to the judgment rules.
- Decisions by the Jury are final.
- A panel of judges would evaluate each software during the two days competition. The decision of the panel of judges will be final and binding. Evaluation will be done at any time without informing the participants.
- If a program is found to be a replica of any existing software, it will be considered as cheating and will lead to disqualification.
- Any misconduct from a participant will result in the disqualification of the team from the competition.
